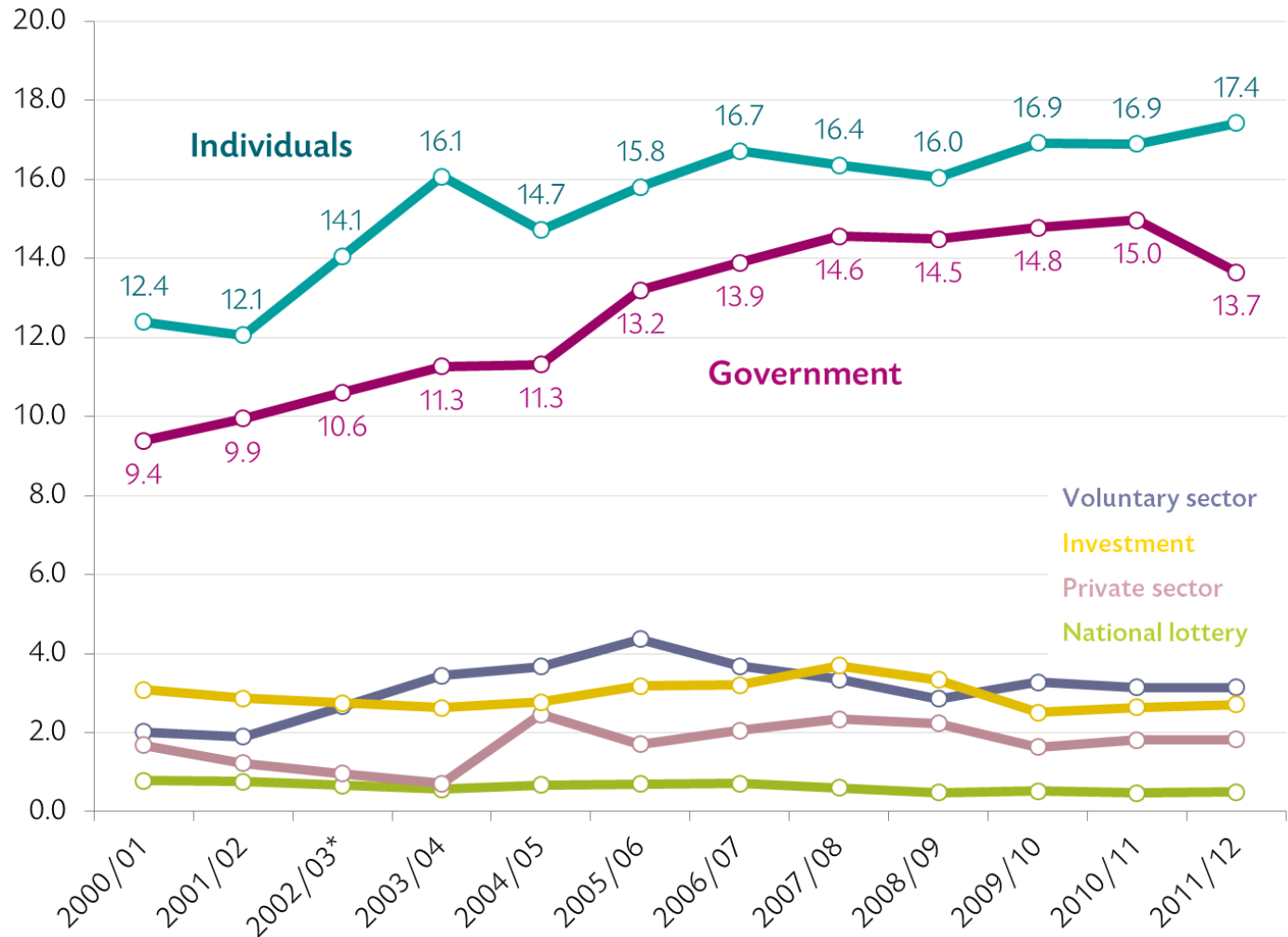


Size and scope of the voluntary sector

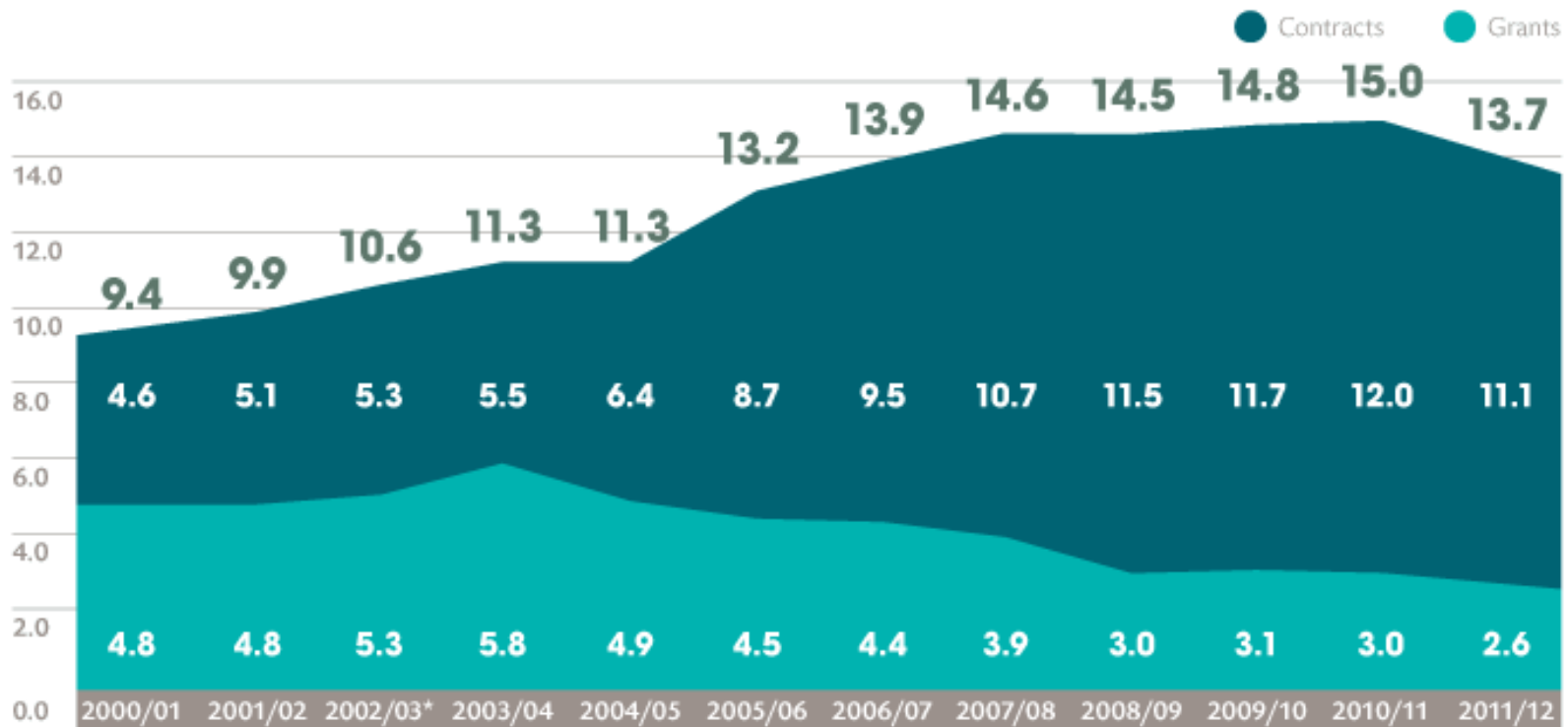

Sources of voluntary sector income since 2000

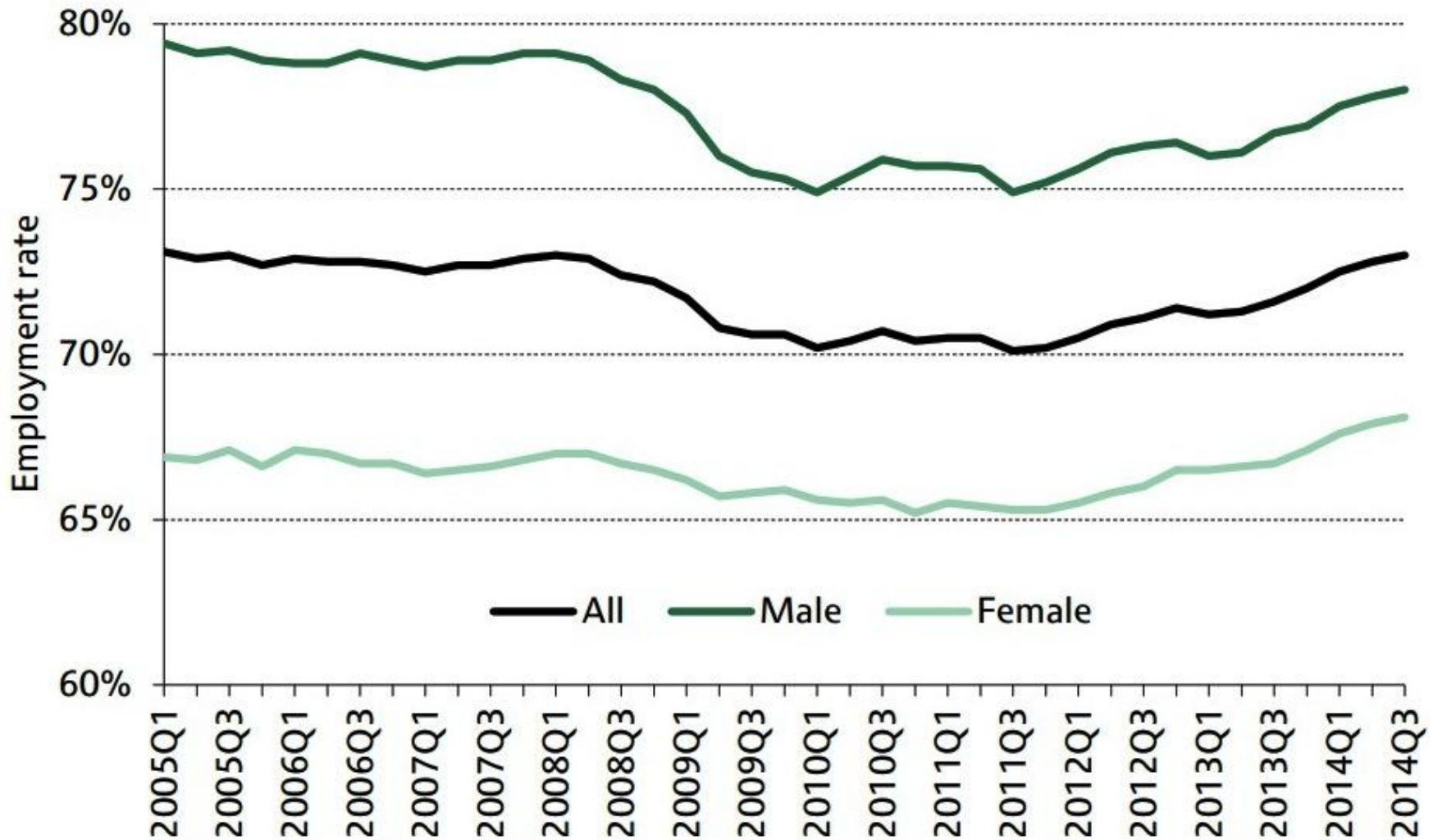
Income sources

(£ billions, real terms)



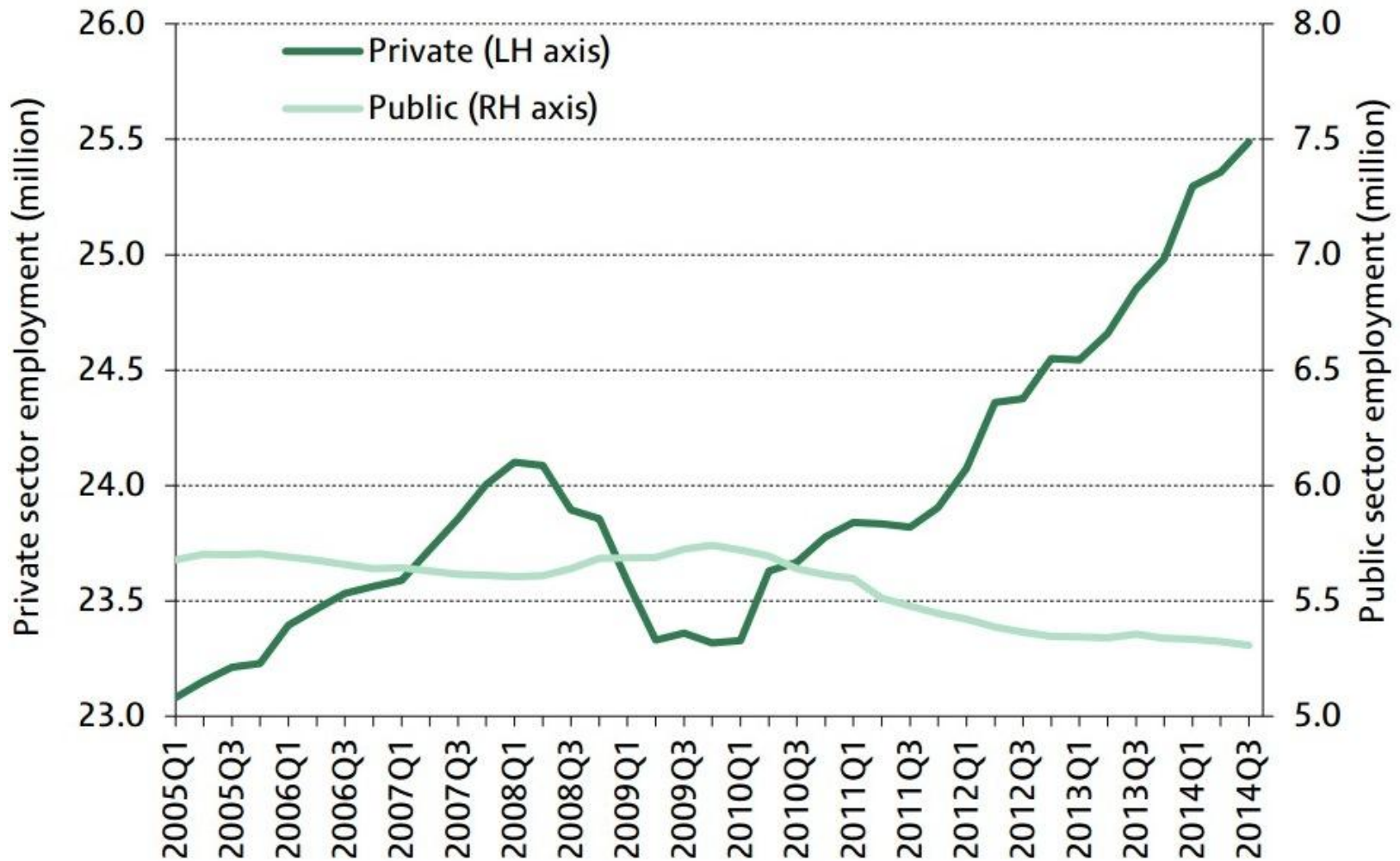
Voluntary sector grant and contract income from government (£ billions)



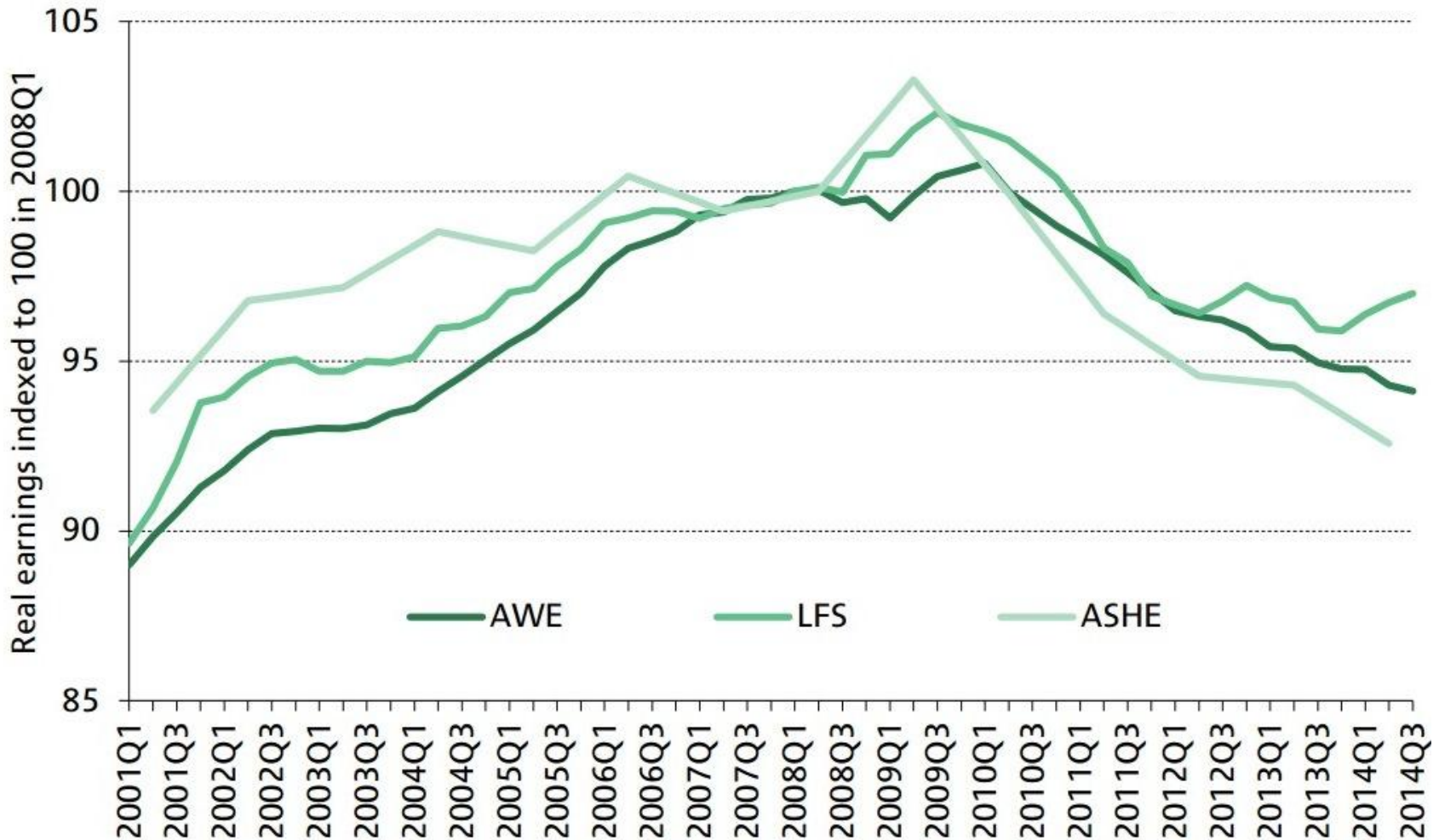
Employment rate since 2005

- Replaces all means-tested benefits and tax credits for work-age adults
 - Key features:
 - Make work pay
 - Monthly payments
 - Responsive
 - Conditionality
 - Delayed rollout

 - Payment model
 - Performance
