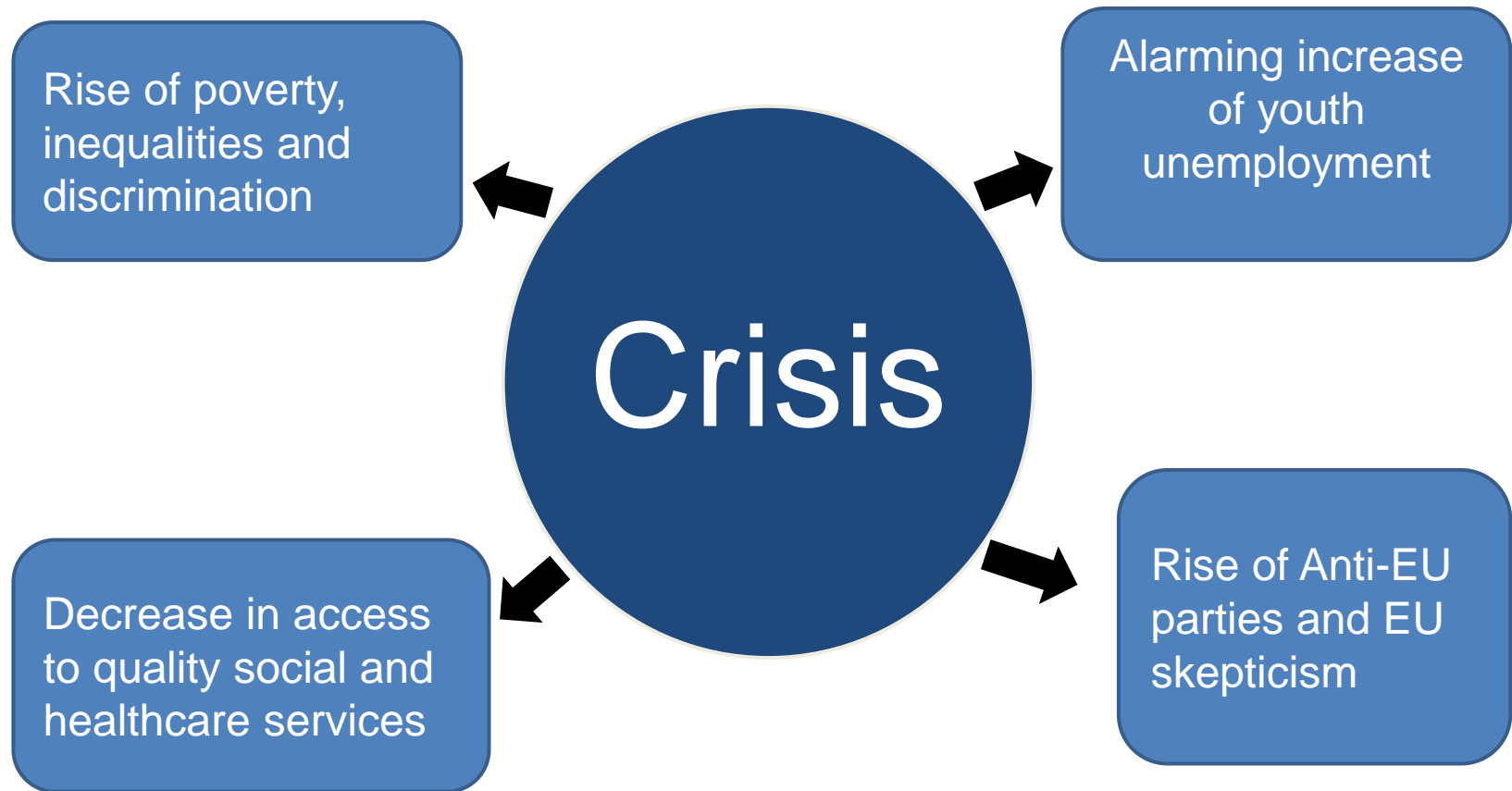

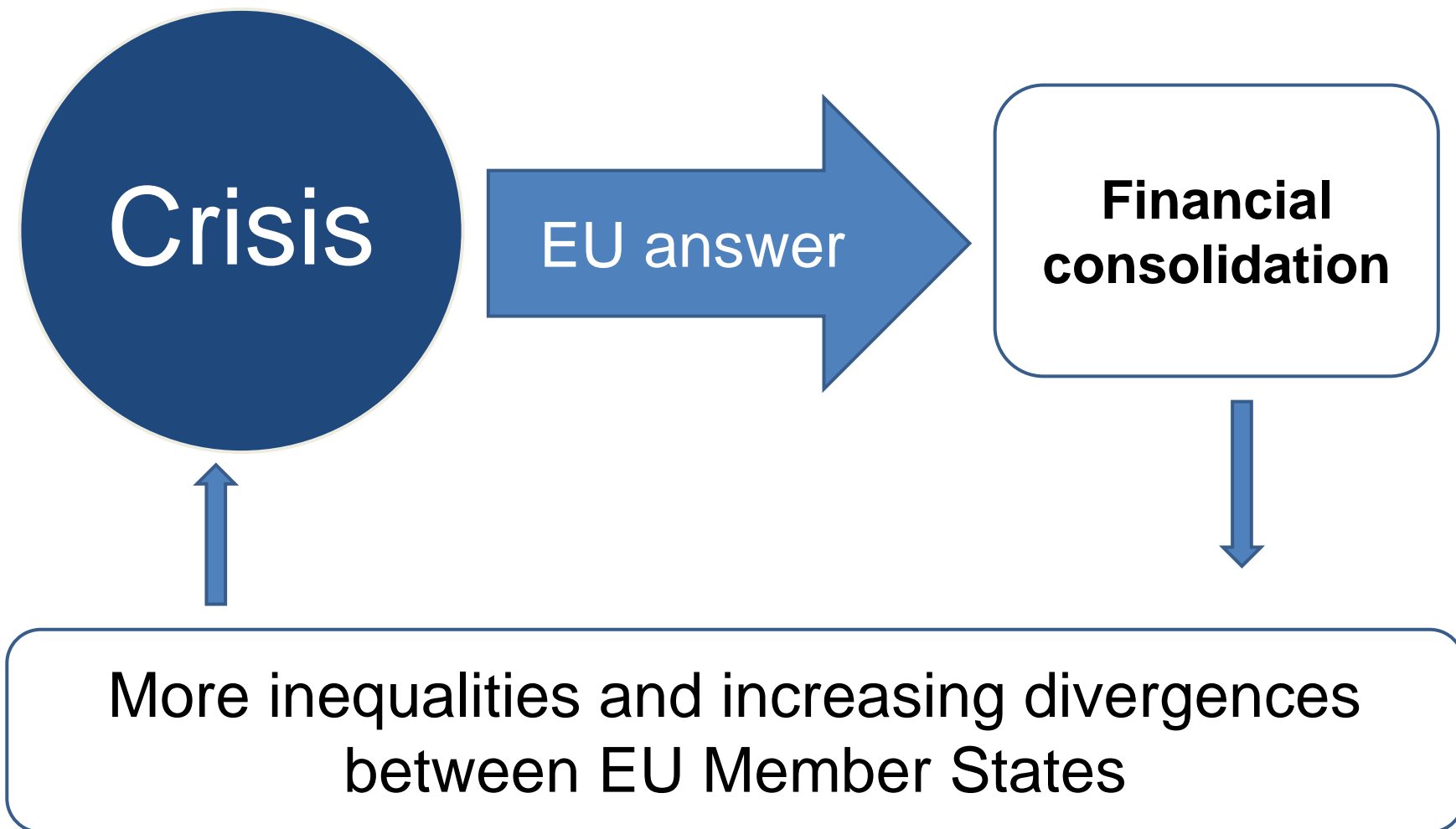

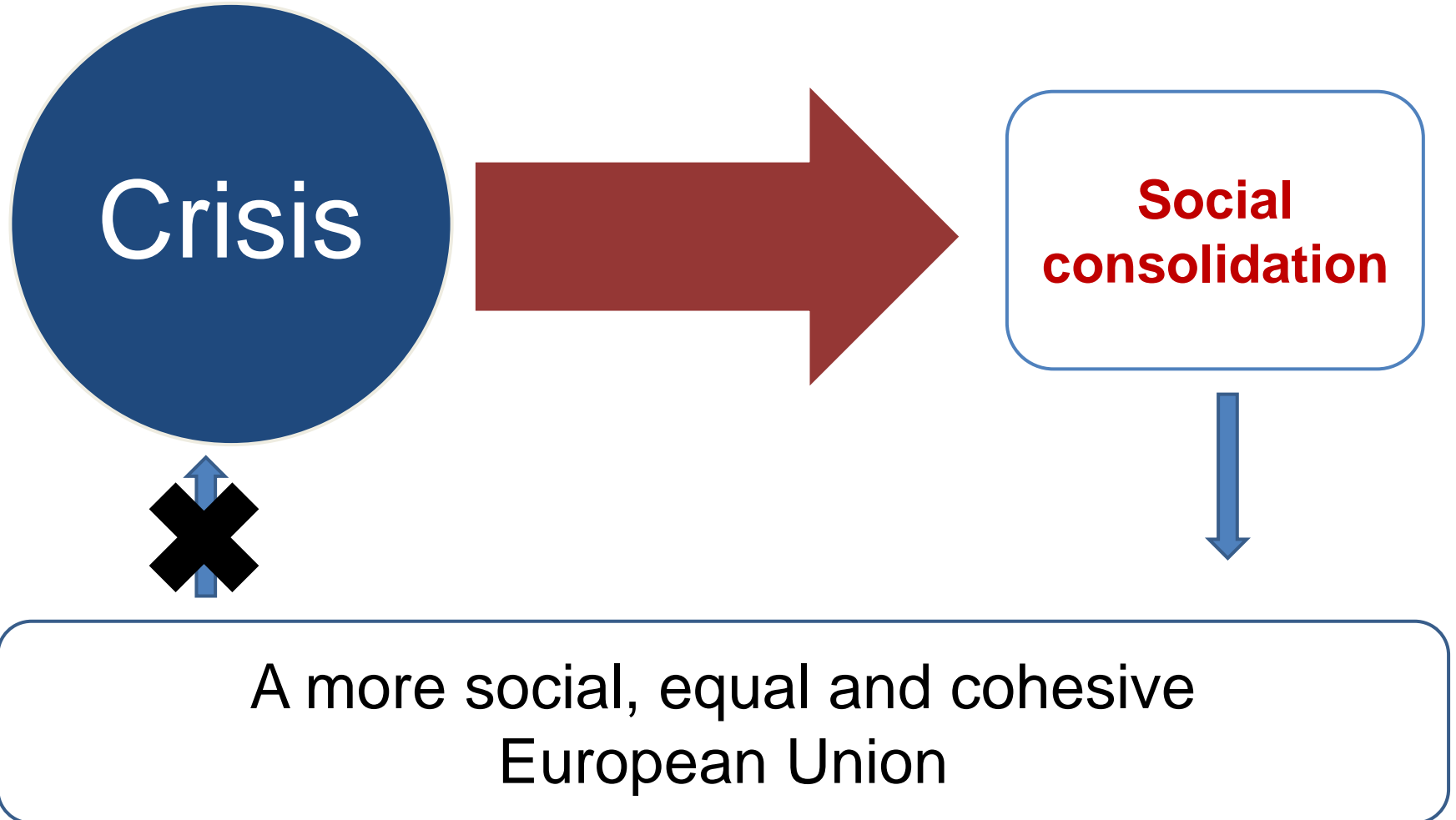

# Social Progress Watch Initiative

## What is the Social Progress Watch?

A monitoring tool to evaluate progress made towards a more social and cohesive European Union within the framework of the European Semester.

## How does it work?

- **Analysis** of Member States performances in promoting quality employment, active inclusion, social cohesion, non-formal and informal learning, equality and solidarity
- Development of **concrete recommendations** to the European institution and Member States on how to spur social consolidation in the European Union

# Our benchmarks

## 1. Fighting unemployment

- *Promoting initiative aimed at providing quality and inclusive employment for vulnerable groups (in particular NEETs and migrants).*

## 2. Improving access to and provision of quality social and healthcare services for all

- *Ensuring universal access to social services as well as quality employment in the healthcare and social sector*

## 3. Promoting access to and participation in lifelong learning

- *Encouraging participation in lifelong learning*
  - *especially non-formal and informal learning*
  - *with specific focus on: NEETs and school dropouts*

# Our benchmarks

## 4. Promoting, reinforcing and supporting social economy

- *Promoting alternative economic models based on the values of co-operation, inclusivity, trust, democratic legitimacy, equality and reinvestment of benefits, that support the creation of sustainable, inclusive and quality jobs.*

## 5. Strengthening active citizenship and volunteering for social cohesion

- *Promoting people's empowerment and social engagement, such as volunteering, that are crucial aspects of the creation of a more cohesive society*

## 6. Fighting discrimination and social exclusion

- *Promoting a right-based approach to remove obstacles for the vulnerable people to access their rights as well as to receive equal treatment.*
