During the Training Academy the participants will gain a strong understanding of the link between global and local policies and on how social, economic and political developments at global level have an impact on local policies. To begin with, the participants will increase their knowledge and understanding on intercultural dialogue. Therefore the training will begin with self reflection and participants own "cultural backpack". Afterwards they will learn to set a video presentation based on training by an expert. The last part of the day combines the factors of equality and wellbeing in societal level and thus highlights the importance of local inclusive communities. The whole day is facilitated with participatory methods enabling participants to contribute the whole process. At the end of the day the participants thus have

- Become a group
- Connected local and global policies as a whole, big picture
- Reflected their own cultural identity
- Tried and learnt intercultural dialogue related exercises to take home
- Shared ideas and learnt new ones to build inclusive communities
- Started making a short video of course outputs

The second day is organised in a more traditional way. The participants will work in two workshops facilitated by experts in order to share experiences and put into practise main points. During the afternoon we will hear the outcomes of the workshops in plenary session and finish the day with video editing based on the previous days' afternoon training. After the evening the participants have created videos highlighting course themes of their own preferences. At the end of the second day the participants thus have

- Learnt from an expert of service provision to vulnerable groups and of promoting tolerance
- Combined their experiences and expert's recommendations in work groups to develop new strategies
- Presented their work group outputs in plenary
- Finished a short video of course outputs

The final day begins with watching the videos edited by the participants. Afterwards there will be the last session regarding local strategies to support up-holding democracy. The session is again facilitated with participatory methods. After the lunch there will be final conclusions and feedback of the whole training. At the end of the training the participants have thus

- Learnt how to promote a culture of peace and tolerance as of through the key role of civic education and civic engagement, and local strategies to support up-holding democratic values
- Gained new ideas on how to foster integration through the promotion of economic, social and cultural rights
- Learnt to build more cohesive, inclusive and equal societies
- Created a whole idea of SOLIDAR and its activities and built a network within
